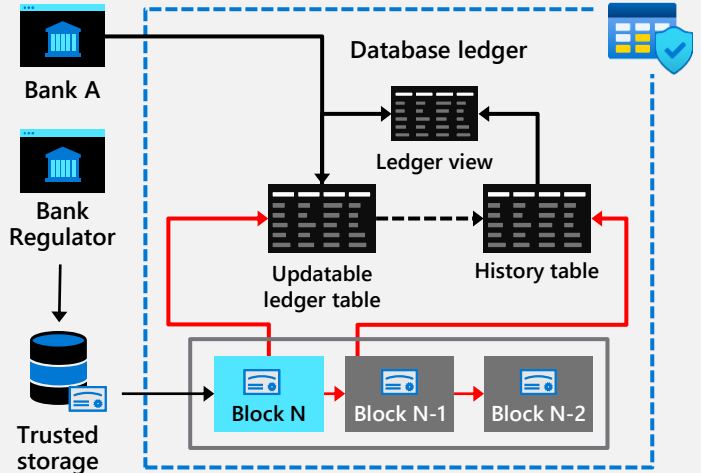
- Automatically scan on-prem SQL Server to capture metadata

Enhanced security, including **SQL Server Ledger** to ensure data integrity

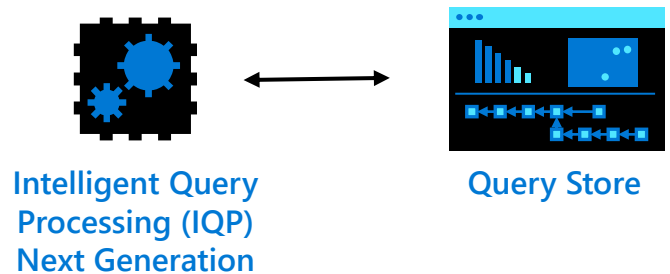
- Use an immutable ledger to protect data from tampering by malicious actors
